grantor for and in the name, place and stead of said grantor, from this date, in the United States (the "territory") and in all Customs Districts, either in writing, electronically, or by other
authorized means, to:

Make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any customs entry, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet, shipper's export declaration, commercial invoice, insurance certificate,
draft or any other document(s) required by law or regulation in connection with the exportation, importation or transportation of any merchandise in or through the customs territory, shipped
or consigned by or to said grantor;

Perform any act or condition which may be required by law or in connection with such merchandise deliverable to or from said grantor; to receive or ship any merchandise;

Make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title; make entry or collect drawback; and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any statement or certificate required by law or
regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such document is intended for filing with Customs:

Sign, seal, and deliver for any as the act of said grantor any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise or merchandise exported
with or without benefit of drawback or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unlading or navigation of any vessel or
other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor, and any and all bonds which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable laws and regulations, consignee's and
owner's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits or statements in connection with the entry of merchandise;

Sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing, lading, unlading, or operation of any
vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor;

Authorize other Customs Brokers duly licensed within the territory to act as grantor's agent; to receive, endorse and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in grantor's name drawn
on the Treasurer of the United States or otherwise on behalf of grantor, if the grantor is a nonresident of the Territory, to accept service of process on behalf of the grantor;

And generally to transact Customs business, including filing of claims or protests under Section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930, or pursuant to other laws of the Territories, in which said
grantor is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by agent and attorney;

Giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said grantor could do if present and acting,
hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents;

The Exporter/Importer hereby certified that all statements and information contained in the documentation provided to the Customs House Broker/Forwarding Agent relating to the
exportation/importation are true and correct. Furthermore, the Exporter/Importer understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent statements or
for the violation of any United States laws or regulations on an exportation/importation.

This power of attorney is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given and received by the Port Director of Customs. (If the donor of this power of attorney is a
partnership, the said power shall in no case have any force or effect in the Territory after the expiration of two (2) years from the date of its execution).

Pursuant to the Customs Regulations 111.29(b), if you are the importer of record, payment to the broker will not relieve you of liability for Customs charges (duties, taxes, or other debts owed
Customs) in the event the charges are not paid by the broker. Therefore, if you pay by check, Customs charges may be paid with a separate check made payable to the U.S. Customs
Service, which shall be delivered to Customs by the broker. Importers who wish to utilize this procedure must contact our office in advance to arrange timely receipt of duty checks.

- Blank 1** IRS/EIN No. is the company Federal I.D. Number.
Social Security No. is used in this Blank if the importer is an individual.
Customs Assigned No. is used in this Blank if the importer does not have a Federal I.D. Number or a Social Security Number.
- Blank 2** Check the appropriate box for your business type.
- Blank 3** Name of importing company or individual. If company is a partnership, list names of all partners.
- Blank 4** Fill in this Blank whether the importer is doing business as a corporation, individual, sole proprietorship or partner.
- Blank 5** Fill in this Blank the State where business is incorporated.
- Blank 6** Fill in this Blank the physical address of the importer of record.
U.S. Customs will not accept a P.O. Box as a valid address.
- Blank 7** Name of importing company or individual. If company is a partnership, list names of all partners.
- Blank 8** Signature of a Corporate Officer is required.

- Blank 9** Fill in the Title of the person signing the Power of Attorney.
